Introduction:

This is a very unique year with challenges that we have never dealt with before. That being said, requiring a traditional service project may not be “do-able”. We do not know what our community will look like in terms of things opening up and we don’t want to require of you anything that may potentially be harmful. Therefore, we have come up with an alternative to traditional service projects.

Your Service Project for This Summer:

Students will put together a slideshow (using Google Slides) presenting a possible service project NJHS could do as a group in the upcoming year. You need to make a choice of which type of service project you would like to design: a traditional service project or a service project that could be completed by the chapter with social-distancing restrictions. Please understand that you are not completing the actual project. You are designing a project that the chapter could complete during the upcoming school year.

*****Regardless of which option that you choose, this is NOT a group project. Each member should have their own unique project.**

Requirements for the Slide Show:

Slide Show (must contain 5 slides):

- Slide 1: Title slide- Your name and your project name (Be sure to mention whether it is a traditional or social-distancing service project!)
- Slide 2: The purpose of the project
 - Who will benefit?
 - Why would this project be beneficial for the chapter to do?
- Slide 3: Project Specifics
 - What supplies would be needed?
 - Is there any cost to the chapter?
 - How much time would be needed to complete the project?
 - Are there any other resources needed, such as transportation, etc.?
- Slide 4: Communication/Outside Organizations
 - Are there any other organizations that we will need to contact or work with to complete this project?
 - How would we contact these organizations? Include phone numbers, websites, email addresses, etc.
- Slide 5: Conclusion
 - Why did you choose this as a project for our chapter to do?
 - Why is it important to YOU?
