**RE: FY2021 State Aid Reconstruction of Amherst Avenue – Phase II**

Remington & Vernick Engineers is the municipal engineer for the City of Margate. We have prepared plans and specifications for the Reconstruction of Amherst Avenue from Gladstone Avenue to Douglass Avenue.

The upcoming construction on Amherst Avenue will include upgrades and replacement of water mains, storm sewer pipes and inlets, upgrades of sanitary sewer facilities, replacement of the concrete curb, gutter, driveway aprons, handicap ramps, and miscellaneous sidewalk pieces, followed by new asphalt paving.

The contract for this work has been awarded to South State Inc. of Bridgeton, New Jersey (856-451-5300). The contractor expects to begin work on Wednesday, **February 23, 2022**. Work hours are typically 7:00 AM-3:30 PM Monday thru Friday. The contractor is planning to close the roadway for the duration of the construction. Parking will not be permitted on the street until the project is complete.

Should damages occur to your property, please contact Robert Smith in our office. The contractor is responsible to repair any damage as a result of construction. If sod and/or sprinklers are damaged during construction, no reimbursements to property owners will be made for irrigation or sod repairs unless pre-approved by this office. Because this is a heavy construction project and large construction equipment must be used, there will be inconveniences.

We anticipate that this project will be complete by the end of April 2022.
