Electronics Policy

Unauthorized electronics (cell phones, e-readers, Smartwatches, etc...) are **NOT** permitted at any time during testing.

Prior to the test, each teacher will remind students to verify that they have turned off all electronics and that they are in their lockers/backpacks away from the testing location.

Should an unauthorized electronic device be observed during testing, it would be considered a security breach requiring the school to notify the NJDOE immediately of the violation.

- o The student's test will be stopped and possibly voided pending an investigation as to the extent of the security breach.
- o The device will be confiscated to be returned to the child's parent upon completion of the investigation and guidance from the NJDOE.
