The U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA), the federal agency that oversees the nation's school meal programs, has long had guidance in place for feeding children during unexpected school closures-whether caused by weather, safety concerns, labor disputes, or other unforeseen causes.

For all students and their siblings who are 18 years old or younger, the USDA has extended free lunches until December 31st or until funds are depleted.

For any orders being delivered, an adult must be present at drop off which will be approximately 11am- 11:30am.
